

## Laudato Si' Action Platform Commitment EXAMEN

## Basic Steps of Examen - Individual or Communal

- 1. Quiet yourself and become aware of God's presence with, within and about you. Ask God for light.
- 2. Give thanks for the gifts of the day.
- 3. Consider one of the LSAP Commitments below and review the day/week.
- 4. Ask for the guidance of the Holy Spirit as you reflect on the activities of the day or week, your encounter with God in others either personally or digitally, in nature. (For example, how was integral ecology manifested to you today?)
- 5. Reflect on your responses to these encounters. Notice what you could have done differently.
- 6. Share your reflections with the community.
- 7. Close with either a prayer or an image of creation you would like to remember for tomorrow.
